- **Tom Brady** - Brady pulls off the Old Hollywood Style very nicely with a great tux. He looks classy and well put together with a hair style that not everyone can do. This slick look requires the hair to be medium in length - and if you wanna do it at home - simply gel back your hair completely using a comb.



- **Ben Affleck** - This is a very flattering hairstyle for the "Company Men" director. We call this a classic *Hollywood* hairstyle. He's trying to pull off the old-Hollywood look of someone like *Humphrey Bogart*, which has been made popular since by actors like *George Clooney*. His side part (beginning at the arch of his eyebrow) is very smooth and neatly in appearance and you can achieve this at home using a shiny pomade product.



- **Denis Leary** - This long layered style suits Leary's "bad boy" image perfectly. His bangs are long in the front and have been cut using a razor at the ends to create textured edges with volume above the ears while widening his forehead. This hair style works best for straight hair.



- **John Krasinski**- It seems like he has no idea what he is trying to do with his hair. His look seems really confused and the lack of attention compliments his comedic image.



- **Matt Damon** - This Boston boy has a tough rugged look with his hair looking short along with a very clean cut. This hairstyle is ideal for men with a classic square face and a prominent square jawline. The short clean cut look with a sleek edge can be achieved with longer hair in front and roundly tapered hair on the top. To achieve this look at home, apply pomade to the hair when wet, brush up and style with finger tips.



- **Steve Carell** - This side part proves that Carell is playing it very safe for the award show he's attending. You can do this at home by using a blow dryer on the hair. First part your hair, blowdry the hair in the direction you want the hair to go and then apply gel or hairspray.



- **Taylor Twellman**- This look is very suitable for a soccer player. He looks like he just rolled out of bed but had enough time to give his hair some texture using pomade. This look works for men with thicker hair that like a shorter more controllable hair style.
